### Responsibility Contract for Overnight Trip

You must remember that from the time of departure to your arrival home, you are the responsibility of the District.

- A. Refrain at all times from the consumption of alcoholic beverages, all tobacco products and alternative nicotine products (including but not limited to, JUULing, e-cigarettes, and vaping products) and/or drugs unless said drugs are prescribed by a physician, and dispensed by school personnel, and/or possession is properly authorized pursuant in accordance the Student Handbook.
- B. Sleep in my assigned room and not visit students in other rooms;
- C. Keep an assigned chaperone advised of my whereabouts at all times;
- D. Attend and be on time for all mandatory activities and meal functions;
- E. Adhere to all established curfews;
- F. Conduct myself in such a manner as to bring pride to oneself, family, school, and community;
- G. Adhere to any established dress code;
- H. Comply, throughout the trip, with any and all instructions directed to me and/or the group by a chaperone or staff member; and
- I. Follow the Student Code of Conduct.

If a problem arises that is serious enough in nature to warrant the below-named student's removal from the travel group, we (the Student and Parent/Guardian) agree to bear any additional costs to return the Student home.

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### Overnight Trip Consent Form

As used herein, "Hilliard" shall include, but not be limited to, the Hilliard City School District Board of Education, its heirs, successors, assigns, agents, administrators, teachers, chaperones, employees, licensees, or any volunteer assisting the foregoing; "Activity" is the overnight trip to \_\_\_\_\_; and "Undersigned" shall be the parent and/or guardian of the student participating in the Activity.

The Undersigned understands and is aware that during the Activity in which the student is participating under the direction of Hilliard, certain risks and dangers may occur, including but not limited to, hazards of accidents or illnesses, the forces of nature, personal injuries, theft and/or destruction of personal property, acts of third persons, and travel by airplane, automobile, bus, train or other conveyance.

In exchange for Hilliard allowing the student to participate in the Activity, the Undersigned hereby assumes the risks as set forth above and the Undersigned on his/her own behalf and on behalf of his/her child hereby releases, discharges and/or waives any and all liability, claims, damages, causes of actions and/or demands against Hilliard of every kind and nature whatsoever which may arise from or in connection with the Activity. The Undersigned further agrees to indemnify and hold Hilliard harmless from any claim arising out of or related to the student's participation in the Activity. This release shall be binding upon the Undersigned and the heirs, next of kin, executors, administrators and personal representatives of the Undersigned.

The Undersigned understands and agrees that the Student Code of Conduct shall be in full force and effect during the Activity.

As a condition of participating, the Undersigned understands and agrees that student's bags and accommodations may be searched in the event that a reasonable suspicion arises that the student has violated the law or the Student Code of Conduct. Illegal drugs, alcohol, all tobacco products and alternative nicotine products (including, but not limited to, JUULing, e-cigarettes, and vaping products) weapons, and other contraband are strictly prohibited at all times.

Students who violate the Code of Conduct and/or any state or federal laws are subject to being sent home immediately at their expense. There will not be an opportunity for appeal prior to the decision to be sent home. The decision to send a student home will be made by the principal or designee in consultation with the trip sponsor and will be considered final. Violations of the Student Code of Conduct may also result in consequences after students return after the conclusion of the trip. By signing this consent, the Undersigned acknowledges receiving this information and affirms their agreement with this procedure.

Students who are disciplined prior to leaving for the trip and who are serving a suspension or expulsion on the date of departure and/or at any time during the time period of the trip will be denied participation in the trip and will not be eligible for a refund of trip costs.

The Undersigned understands that transportation, if the student is ill, injured or must return at a different time than scheduled for the Activity, will be the financial responsibility of the Undersigned.
